Abstract.- Public Sector Undertakings-Use of company cars for non-duty purposes-Revised orders issued.

ORDER

As per para (iii) of the annexure to G.O. 1st cited, the rate of hire charges per months for the use of company vehicles for non-duty purposes by the Chief Executives of Public Sector Undertakings was enhanced from Rs.100 to Rs.150 and from Rs.150 to Rs.225 per mensem for small cars and big cars respectively. In the case of A.C. cars, the amount to be recovered was fixed at Rs.200 and Rs. 300p.m., For A.C. small cars and A.C. big cars respectively. The limit of 500 kms prescribed for monthly use was then revised for a quarter and the Chief Executives were allowed to use the company vehicles for non-duty purposes for 1500 kms. In a quarter on payment of Rs.450, Rs.675, Rs.600 and Rs.900 per quarter for small cars, big cars, A.C. small cars and A.C. big cars respectively, as per G.O.s 2nd and 3rd cited.

2. In view of the sharp increase in fuel and operational costs of vehicles, the rates prescribed are revised as follows:

For small cars	..	Rs. 1500 per quarter
For big cars (Engine have above 16HP)	..	Rs. 2250 per quarter
For A.C. cars small	..	Rs.2000 per quarter
For A.C. cars big	..	Rs.3000 per quarter

3. For journeys in excess of 1500 kms per quarter, recovery at the rate of Rs. 2 per km. will be made. If the quarterly ceiling of 1500 kms has not been reached in any particular quarter, the balance should not be carried forward to the subsequent quarter.

These orders will take effect from 1st January 1991.
