Abstract.- Scales of Pay Chief Executives of the State Public Sector Undertakings-Revised –Orders issued

Read.- G.O. (Ms) No.70/87/Plg., dated 19th October 1987.

ORDER

In terms of the G.O. cited the existing scales of pay (State BPE Schedules) of the Chief Executives of the State Public Sector Undertakings are as follows:-

2. In the light of the revision of the Central BPE Schedules and the State Government's pay Revision Orders merging D.A. at 608 points, Government are pleased to issue the following orders.

3. The existing BPE Schedules, given in column 2 below, will be revised as given in column 4 with effect from 1st April 1992.

There will be no ad hoc relief attached to any of the revised schedules.

4. Schedule A, B and C will carry Industrial D.A. payable to the incumbents of top posts in Central Government Public Enterprises for the period from 1st April 1992 onwards, while Schedule D, E and F will carry D.A. at the rates payable to the State Government employees from time to time.

5. Only the Chief Executives and Functional Directors who are drawing as on 1st April 1992, their pay in the existing State BPE Schedules are entitled to get their pay fixed in the corresponding revised schedule. The incumbents can opt for the revised scale on any date beginning from 1st April 1992.

6. Pay in the revised Schedules A, B and C will be fixed as follows:-

Add to the basic pay as on 1st April 1992 (or on the date of change over) the ad hoc relief, eligible fitment benefit as per the statement given below and industrial D.A. of Rs.838.35 at AICPI 685. If the resultant amount is a stage in the revised schedule, pay shall be fixed at that stage and if not at the stage next above.

7. Pay in the revised Schedule D, E and F will be fixed as follows:-

Add to the eligible basic pay as on the date of change over to the revised scale, the D.A. and ad hoc D.A. admissible at 608 points of AICIPI and a weightage of Rs.60. If the resultant amount is a stage in the revised scale, pay shall be fixed at that stage and if not at the stage next above. Stagnation increments will be allowed as in Government Service.

8. Eligibility for residential accommodation will be as per the existing norms prescribed in G.O. (Ms). No. 70/87/Plg., dated 19th October 1987.

9. In the absence of residential accommodation, H.R.A. will be paid at the rates and subject to the conditions specified in the pay revision orders for Government employees (vide G.O. (P) 480/89/Fin., dated 1st November 1989).

10. C.C.A at the uniform rate of Rs. 15 will be paid subject to the conditions specified in G.O.(P) 480/89/Fin., dated 1st November 1989.

11. Pending finalisation of the reclassification of Public Sector Undertakings no claim for a higher BPE Schedule will be entertained.
