Abstract: - Public Enterprises Bureau of Public Enterprises and Public Enterprises Board- Qualification and method of appointment on deputation basis as Director (Bureau of Public Enterprises)—Orders issued.

Read: - 1. G.O.(Ms).No.15/92/ID., dated 23rd January 1992.
2. Lr. No. MD/DO/BPE/92/056, dated 4th September 1992 from Sri. B.S. Sastry, Managing Director, Travancore Titanium Products Ltd. Thiruvananthapuram.

ORDER

In the G.O. read above Government have ordered the reconstitution of Bureau of Public Enterprises (BPE) and public Enterprises Board (PEB). According to the staff structure laid down therein, the Bureau of Public Enterprises will be headed by a Director who will be a Senior Officer from Government or Public Sector of a suitable rank. The qualifications to posts other than Director have been specified in the G.O. read above.

2. The following qualification is prescribed for the post of Director (BPE):

Qualification.- He must be a Senior Officer from Government or a Manager from Public Sector Undertakings having Membership in the Institute of Company secretaries of India or Chartered Accountants of India or M.B.A. Degree.

Experience.- He should have experience of 10 to 15 years in Supervisory Capacity, out of which a minimum of 3 years should be in the Central or State Bureau of Public Enterprises.

Method of appointment. - BY deputation in the event of non availability of suitable nomination from public Sector undertakings, Junior I.A.S. Officers having previous experience as Chief Executive of a Public Sector Undertaking will also be considered.

Scale of Pay. - Rs. 2825-4095 plus special pay of Rs. 300. (Identical to that of Additional Secretary to Government.)

3. Government are also pleased to order that the Contingent Expenditure will be continued to be met from the provision under the Major Head “3451 (Secretariat Economic Service)” as at present.
