Local Self Government Department - Establishment - Creation of Permanent/ Supernumerary Posts in addition to cadre under the Commissionerate of Rural Development and the Panchayat Department for the absorption and posting of the staff of SERIFED in Government Service - Sanctioned - Orders Issued.

ORDER

As per the G.O. read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above , Government have decided to liquidate the SERIFED ( Kerala State Sericulture Co-operative Federation Limited) and to transfer its assets and to absorb its staff into the Department of Panchayat, the Commissionerate of Rural Development and the Kerala Khadi and Village Industries Board with specific terms and conditions.

(2) Accordingly the Managing Director of SERIFED as per the letters read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above has proposed the absorption of 283 employees of the SERIFED (43 Assistant Sericulture Officers , 152 Field Assistants, 13 Typists , 1 Confidential Assistant , 6 Drivers, 1 Mechanic, 49 Peons/Helpers and 18 Part Time Sweepers) in Government Service under the Commissionerate of Rural Development and the Department of Panchayat .

(3) On the basis of the decision in the G.O. read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above , the 283 employees of the SERIFED are to be absorbed in Government Service under the Department of Panchayat and the Commissionerate of Rural Development by creating 283 Permanent and Supernumerary posts , in addition to the existing cadre in the Commissionerate of Rural Development and the Department of Panchayat .

(4) The Commissioner for Rural Development as per the letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above and the Director of Panchayat as per the letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above have submitted proposals for the creation of the above said posts on permanent/ supernumerary basis ; for absorption of the staff of SERIFED under the Commissionerate of Rural Development and the Department of Panchayat . The posts of Assistant Sericulture Officers, Drivers, Mechanic, and Part Time Sweepers

are to be created as Supernumerary posts and the posts of Field Assistants , Typists , Confidential Assistant and Peons/Helpers are to be created as Permanent Post in addition to the existing cadre in the Department of Panchayat and the Commissionerate of Rural Development. Out of the total 283 posts proposed for creation , 49 posts will come under the Commissionerate of Rural Development and 234 posts will come under the Panchayat Department as detailed below:-

(5) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for the creation of 283 posts under the Commissionerate of Rural Development and the Department of Panchayat on permanent /supernumerary basis, in addition to the cadre as detailed above, with effect from 01.07.2010 for the absorption of the staff of the SERIFED in government service, subject to the following conditions:-

- (I) The Supernumerary posts created under the Commissionerate of Rural Development and the Panchayat Department will be treated as vanishing category.
- (II) 43 posts of Assistant Sericulture Officers and 6 posts of Drivers are created under the Commissionerate of Rural Development Department as supernumerary posts.
- (III) One post of Mechanic and 18 posts of Part Time Sweepers are created under the Panchayat Department as supernumerary posts .
- (IV) The 152 posts of LD Clerks , 1 post of Confidential Assistant , 13 posts of Typists and 49 posts of Poens/Helpers under the Panchayat Department are created as permanent posts in addition to the cadre.
- (V) The Field Assistants are posted in the newly created posts of LD Clerks in Panchayat Department.
- (VI) The seniority of the employees absorbed will be fixed as on the date of their entry to the new department.

(6) The 283 employees thus absorbed to the Commissionerate of Rural Development and the Department of Panchayat are posted against the created posts (the 49 posts created in the

Commissionerate of Rural Development and 234 posts in the Department of Panchayat), with retrospective effect from 01.07.2010.

(7) Further follow up action regarding the posting of the 49 employees absorbed in the Commissionerate of Rural Development should be taken by the Commissioner for Rural Development and in respect of 234 employees absorbed in the Panchayat Department by the Director of Panchayats.
