ORDER

As per the Government Order read above, instructions were issued specifying the maximum period of joining time that can be allowed by the Appointing Authorities to NORKA's working abroad, advised by KPSC to join duty in Government service. When instructions were issued to regulate the procedure regarding granting of extension of joining time to candidates advised for appointment by Kerala Public Service Commission as per the circular read as 2nd paper above, the said provision was also incorporated.

2. Recently, Government received a number of requests from employees working in private firms on contract basis within Kerala/India, requesting extension of joining time, as they are not in a position to join duty within the time limit now allowed.

3. Government have examined the matter in consultation with Kerala Public Service Commission and are pleased to order that joining time to persons working in private firms on contract basis within Kerala/India up to a maximum period of three months (90 days) can be granted by the Appointing Authority from the date of order of appointment to join in Government service. Their seniority shall be subject to the 1st proviso to Rule 27 (c) of Part II Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules.

4. For granting such extension of time to join duty, the appointing authority should obtain the contract entered into with the private employer and verify it. If the contract is entered into after the receipt of appointment order, extension of time will not be granted. Extension beyond three months will not be considered on any account.
