ORDER

The Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal as per its Order read as 2nd paper above has directed the first respondent, ie. Secretary, Local Self Government Department to consider and take a decision on Ext.P5 representation read as 1st paper above submitted by Smt. Nirmala.P, Retired Superintendent, Thalassery Municipality requesting to set aside the Orders of the Director of Urban Affairs dated 28.04.2008 fixing a liability upon her on excess PF payment after affording an opportunity of hearing to the applicant within 3 months from the date of receipt of a copy of the Order.

Accordingly the petitioner was heard by Government representative on 29.07.2015. The Grievances of the petitioner was examined with respect to the report of Director of Urban Affairs. As per the report of Director of Urban Affairs Smt. P. Nirmala has withdrawn excess amount from her Provident Fund credit as loan and hence Director of Urban Affairs has given direction to Secretary, Chengannur Municipalitay to realize that excess amount from her. The Director of Urban Affairs has also informed that she was heard by him on 19.09.2015 and then she complained that she didn't get the Dearness Allowance arrears credited to her Provident Fund Account for

the period she worked in Chengannur, Kunnankulam and Chavakkad Municipalities. Hence he has given direction to the Secretaries of those Municipalities to give her the amount that was not credited to her PF, directly.

In this circumstances, Director of Urban Affairs is directed to verify all credits due to Smt. P. Nirmala and to recalculate all the amount due to her taking into account her CTD, Provident Fund, Dearness Allowance Arrears etc. and to disburse the amount due to her after realizing the amount she withdrawn in excess from her Provident Fund.

The Order of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal read as 2nd paper above is thus complied.
