As per the G.O.s read as 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, Government have introduced the Green Book & Amber Book for the Financial Year 2016-17 for the proper and timely implementation of plan schemes and as per G.O. read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above Government permitted the administrative departments to issue administrative sanction for all the schemes included in Green Book.

As per the letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above the Commissioner for Rural Development has submitted a detailed proposal for issuing administrative sanction for the plan scheme 'Block Information Centres' listed as item no. 2.2 in the Green Book 2016-17 which aims at building up a comprehensive data base in Block Panchayath Offices thereby providing all the basic information required for Panchayats and Block level planning process on a continuing basis. It also aims to enable the Block Panchayats in the maintenance and updating of the basic information in electronic form which ensures the maintenance of connectivity between Rural Development Agencies/Collectorates and offices of Assistant Development Commissioner and Commissioner for Rural Development. The scheme comprises of the following components.


