O R D E R

The Government of India have launched the scheme National Rurban Mission in a bid to transform rural areas into economically, socially and physically sustainable spaces. The Government of India have given direction to implement the scheme in the state also. Accordingly rural growth clusters have been identified on the basis of certain indexes. Government of India will provide an additional funding support up to 30% of the project cost or Rs.30 Crores per cluster, whichever is lesser for plain areas as Critical Gap Funding (CGF) to bridge the gap in resources for the identified projects. The following clusters are approved by the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India in Kerala.

- 1.Vellanad/Aryanad Cluster (Trivandrum)
- 2.Puthenvelikkara/Kunnukara Cluster (Ernakulam)
- 3.Mangattidam/Kottayam Cluster (Kannur)
- 4.Puthuppally/Manarcadu Cluster (Kottayam)

2) As per Order read as 1st paper above Government of India sanctioned Rs.20 Crores (Rs.5Crores per Cluster) as 1st instalment of NRuM. As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Commissioner for Rural Development has submitted a proposal requesting for a formal Administrative Sanction in order to launch full fledged implementation of the NRuM Scheme in the state and also for the release of the 1st instalment . As per G.O read as 4th paper above an amount of 33.34 Crores has been provided in the newly created Head of Account 2515-00-102-35 SPMRM(P).

3) The Working Group meeting held on 29.03.2017 has considered the above proposal and approved it.

4) In the circumstances, Administrative Sanction is accorded for the implementation of the National Rurban Mission (NRuM) in the above mentioned 4 clusters identified in the State.

5) Sanction is also accorded for the release of Rs.33.34 Crores (Thirty Three Crore and Thirty Four Lakhs) as the central and corresponding State share as the Critical Gap Fund (CGF) for the implementation of the scheme debiting the expenditure from the Head of Account 2515-00-102-35 SPMRM(P) for the year 2016-17.

6) The Controlling Officer will take timely steps to regularise the additional expenditure through re-appropriation of savings only within the grant before the close of the current financial year itself.
